Building Update

New Modular Learning Spaces

The piles are in and on Thursday while we are at the beach the building will be lifted into its final position. It is at this time we will get a new sense of what this imposing structure will look like in relation to our current buildings.

The modules currently on site will, in time, have the addition of front and back decks. Towards the end of March the water tanks and waste system will be in place. Waste water systems will be tracked out to the area alongside the orchard and this will need to be fenced.

All of this work will mean a resetting of our playing fields with topsoil from the construction site being used to fill some of our rabbit holed paddocks.

Resetting the garden and orchard area will be a team effort and we will definitely be calling for helping hands.

It is a massive project and will be a significant addition to our school. Term two will see the Year 1-3 students and staff relocated to their new home.

Last week we received approval from the MOE that additional funds have been allocated to the restoration of the Historic Block. Over 750K has now been set aside for this important task. As mentioned in previous newsletters, the aim is to restore this building to its former glory whilst providing the heat, lighting and acoustics of a modern learning space. Our school is incredibly lucky to have the opportunity to undertake this project.


