

<u>Chickenpox</u> - We have a bit of an breakout of chickenpox at school (in the junior classes) at the moment.



Some symptoms of chickenpox are: tiredness, fever, general aches and pains. Then of course small red spots...

Chickenpox is very contagious and is easily spread through the air. Children will often require 5-10 days for recovery. ALL spots need to be crusted over before your child can return to school. At this stage, this is just in the junior block.
